Requests for Pavement Cores & Pavement Design

- Send all requests to Robin Davis <u>robinm.davis@delaware.gov</u>
- Pavement Coring
 - Include google map or equivalent of the site and the approximate locations marked.
 - Explain the reason for coring or what you are trying to find. The field crew can adjust based on what is found during coring.
- Pavement Design
 - Provide any special conditions known about the area and use (industrial use of turn lane, bus stop, etc.) that could influence design or mix criteria.

Geotech

- Designer For borings completed by M&R please make sure the request includes any special conditions/permits required

Geotech

- Updated guidance will be issued in the new Materials Manual for Consultant managed geotechnical investigations
- Purpose:
 - Request/proposal review by DelDOT's Geotechnical Engineer
 - Consistency in data and boring logs from project to project
 - Continue to maintain good historical records
 - Appropriate laboratory testing from an accredited lab using AASHTO classifications
 - Soil boring data is not just for Design but Construction too

- M&R plant inspectors report improved communication with the field inspectors, continue to build on this.
- During inclement and cold weather, try to release the material as close to when the field is ready for it.
