Getting started with Autodesk:

Autodesk provides students and educators with a free one-year educational access to their products and services after confirming eligibility.

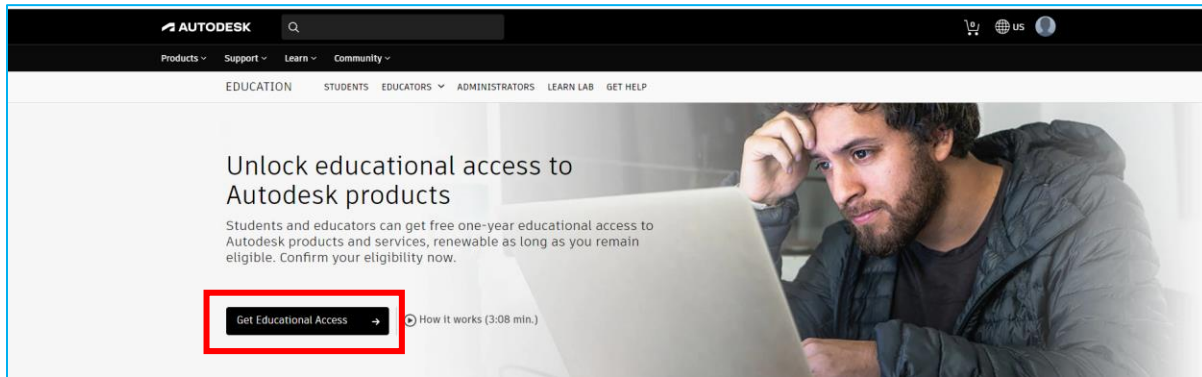
First, navigate to at <https://www.autodesk.com/education/edu-software> and click **Get started**

Create your account:

- Select your educational role and fill out the remaining fields.
- On the following page, fill out your personal information to create your account (Using an email domain associated with the same educational institution is recommended to prove eligibility)
- Click **Done** on the next page and you should be taken back to the education portal

Verify your eligibility:

- Once you've been taken back to the education portal, Click **Get Educational Access**



- Fill out your personal information on the following page and click **CONFIRM**. You should now have educational access to Autodesk products

Download software:

- Sign into your account and navigate to the education portal (Use <https://www.autodesk.com/education/edu-software> to easily return to the portal)
- Select **Get product** on any of the suggested software below to begin downloading the product
 - **Fusion 360**: Compatible with Windows and Mac systems. Requires users to create a 3D model before creating a 2D drawing
 - **AutoCAD**: Compatible with Windows and Mac but Mac users must download “AutoCAD for Mac” to use the software. Does not require a 3D model to create a 2D drawing; users can go straight into creating a 2D drawing if needed
