- A WebEx session is best attended directly from the device you are using. Do not launch or access the WebEx meeting/event through a Remote Desktop connection.


Notification to Attend WebEx Delaware Bicycle Council Meeting


... using the WebEx URL


... using Outlook at your office or home via OWA or O365 Online

Select the Join Meeting link from the e-mail or event calendar. Enter the information as prompted.


First time users will be asked to install the Cisco WebEx Meeting app.
