Dear Mr. Luszc:

Thank you for your letter of March 20 requesting approval to use Pedestrian-Actuated Rectangular Rapid-Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) on a blanket basis at uncontrolled marked crosswalk locations statewide in Delaware. Your request is made under the provisions of Section 1A.10 of the 2009 edition of the *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways* and the Federal Highway Administration's Interim Approval memorandum (IA-21) dated March 20, 2018 for the optional use of RRFBs.

Your request is approved. This approval is granted on a blanket basis for all locations in Delaware at which the Delaware Department of Transportation or local highway agencies install RRFBs under the technical conditions contained in IA-21.

Please develop and periodically update a list of all locations where RRFBs are installed in Delaware. Local jurisdictions that install RRFBs under this Interim Approval should inform your office of such installations so you can maintain a comprehensive list of locations.

For recordkeeping purposes, we have assigned your request the following number and title: "IA-21.3 –Rectangular Rapid-Flashing Beacons at Crosswalks – DE DOT (Statewide)." Please refer to this number and title in any future correspondence.
