- A WebEx session is best attended directly from the devise you are using. Do not launch or access the WebEx meeting/event through a Remote Desktop connection.

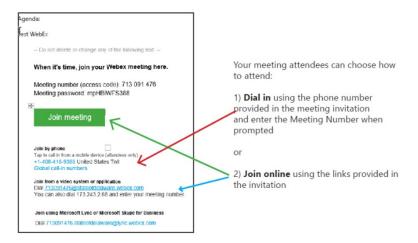
# Notification to Attend WebEx Delaware Bicycle Council Meeting

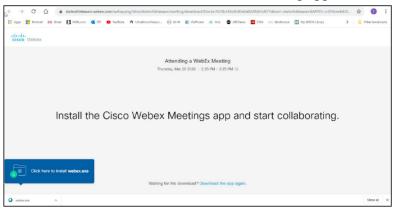
# ... using the WebEx URL

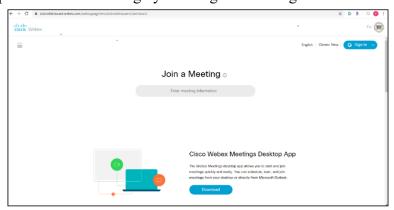
# ... using Outlook at your office or home via OWA or O365 Online

Select the Join Meeting link from the e-mail or event calendar. Enter the information as prompted.

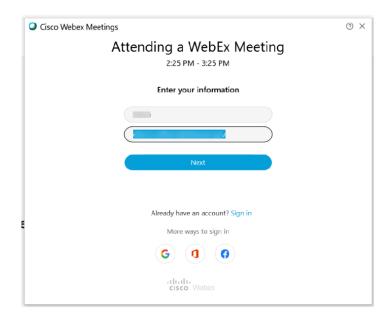
First time users will be asked to install the Cisco WebEx Meeting app.
