

**4.3.7 K-02744. Agricultural Complex
3683 Barratts Chapel Road
SM-00-121.00-01-70**

Description: This 139.7-acre property is located on the north side of Barratts Chapel Road to the west of Double Run. It was once the site of an agricultural complex, but now there are only two large storage sheds on the property.

The northernmost storage shed (.001) is a double-story structure with standing seam metal roofing and cladding, which was built ca. 1975. The rectangular plan is laid out on a concrete block foundation. The shed is accessed through paired sliding barn doors on the west, north, or south sides. The front gable roof has partially collapsed.

A large pre-fabricated storage shed (.002) is located to the southeast. The double story structure has a modified gambrel roof with a shallow roof pitch and steeply pitched walls. Standing seam metal roofing and cladding covers the shed, which can be accessed through paired sliding barn doors on the west side.


Applicable Historic Context(s): Upper Peninsula Zone; Agriculture; Settlement Patterns and Demographic Changes.

Historical Overview: When this complex was surveyed in 1980 (Appendix B), it contained a two-story frame farmhouse, a barn, two sheds, a silo, and a trailer. None of the historic structures remain at this site. Two large storage sheds built ca. 1975 and 1985 are the only structures standing at this site. A round concrete pad, which is believed to be the foundation of the former silo, and an earthen driveway are the only other remains of the historic farmstead.


Aerial mapping from 1937 shows the farmstead surrounded by fields. Only the two sheds appear in aerial photographs after 1992.

Evaluation: No historic structures remain at this site. K-02744 is not eligible for listing in the NRHP.
