The structures (main house & barn) are no longer extant. Removed by DNREC upon their recent acquisition.

The nearby mill complex (S00213/00436 and located north) has changed whereby, several support structures are also not evident from the original forms. This update correlates with the current State of Delaware Contract T201207603 which is managed by DeDOT for DNREC as part of a Dam Safety Program. Additional Architectural and Archaeological Studies in 2014 by McCormick Taylor, Inc. and within the vicinity may provide more information on this property as well as the others in the area. This dwelling was known to be built by George H. Hearn, son of Marcellus W. Hearn, who was manager and later operator the family mill.

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
