

**6.0 SUMMARY AND
RECOMMENDATIONS**



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This addendum presents additional architectural survey work and evaluations associated with the expanded project limits for the SR 1, Little Heaven Intersection project. The expanded APE includes one 50-year-old resource, the Thomas James House, which was previously surveyed in 1980 and recommended eligible for listing in the National Register under Criterion C as part of the current study. Copies of the CRS forms for the Thomas James House, as well as a DOE form including a proposed National Register boundary, may be found in Appendix A of this report. Black and white contact sheets and photograph logs as per DESHPO requirements are being submitted separately from this report.

The Jehu Reed House (CRS No. K-137) was previously listed in the National Register of Historic Places. Although the Jehu Reed House has suffered some physical deterioration, the Jehu Reed House maintains good historic architectural integrity and A.D. Marble & Company recommends that it continue to meet the eligibility criteria established by the NPS (NPS 1997). Although it is assumed that the National Register boundary coincides with the tax parcel; the National Register nomination form does not include a boundary description. Therefore, a National Register boundary has been established for this resource as part of the current study and is included in Appendix B.
