


1.0 INTRODUCTION

Phase I archaeological and historic structures surveys have been completed in conjunction with the proposed State Route (S.R.) 15 (Canterbury Road) Improvements, Holly Hill Road (K447) to Airport Road (K407) project located near Milford (Milford Hundred), Kent County, Delaware (Figure 1). This report presents the results of that research in an abbreviated format. The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) has expressed a desire to streamline the format of survey reports, wherein important information is presented and boilerplate sections (e.g. environmental setting, general cultural background) are eliminated, while continuing to fulfill their agency responsibilities for cultural resources management, protection, and preservation. This report streamlining is most effective as a way to disseminate negative survey results in a timely, easily accessible, and fiscally responsible fashion. When few or no cultural materials or historic structures are identified during cultural resources research, the most important information to be disseminated are the boundaries of the survey area itself and explanations/justifications/suggestions for the lack of evidence of cultural use/occupation.



U.S.G.S. QUAD. SHEET: MILFORD, DEL.


