

c) Spatial subdivisions: The small clusters of graves in the cemetery are arranged in rows.



g) Vegetation: Grassy parcel, mature trees shade the eastern portion of the property. A densely wooded lot borders the southern boundary of the parcel.

h) Other: This small cemetery contains approximately 25 marked graves arranged in rows and in small clusters. Most of the graves are located along the western portion of the parcel; however, a small group stands towards the west side of the cemetery. The stones primarily consists of small, beveled markers, slant markers, and rectangular markers, mostly constructed of granite. However, a few of the older stone are small, stone tablets. The earliest marker appears to date from 1923 and the most recent burial occurred in 1999. Family names in the cemetery include Harris, Waters, Miller, Lewis, Neal, and Thomas.


