According to Delaware's bridge survey (*Delaware's Historic Bridges: Survey and Evaluation of Historic Bridges with Historic Contexts for Highways and Railroads* by Lichtenstein Consulting Engineers, Inc., Paramus, New Jersey, 2000), Bridge S-615 was a 12-foot single span bridge built in 1912 and widened in 1946. It was considered not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places because its integrity had been compromised.

When JMA re-surveyed the property in October 2005, the visible portion of the bridge was reinforced poured concrete that appeared to date to the dualization of the roadway in the 1980s.
