DelDOT Transportation Enhancements (TE) Program

The TE Program established through federal legislation, is a community based program intended to encourage community pedestrian mobility and ease the flow of vehicular traffic while promoting safety for residents and pedestrians.

Proposed Improvements

- Replace existing concrete curb and sidewalks with a new concrete and brick paver walkway on both sides of S. Lincoln Street between Sycamore Street and Linden Street.
- Install decorative light poles that are consistent with other city neighborhood street beautification projects.
- Install ramps, and delineate cross walks with striping at S. Lincoln Street intersections of Sycamore Street, Maple Street & Linden Street.
- Install “Neckdowns” on S. Lincoln Street at the Intersections of Sycamore Street, Maple Street and Linden Street as a Traffic Calming Measure.







Typical Road and Sidewalk Sections




“ACTUAL LOCATION - BEFORE”
