

Closing in on a Recommended Preferred Alternative for US 113 in the Millsboro-South Area...

Your Comments Do Make a Difference!

Come to a Millsboro-South Area public workshop on May 24th or 25th for an update on the retained alternatives, including DeIDOT's anticipated Recommended Preferred Alternative for the Millsboro, Dagsboro, Frankford and Selbyville areas.

The purpose of the US 113 North/South Study is to identify, select and protect an alignment for a limited-access US 113 through Sussex County that meets the future needs of local, seasonal and through traffic in a safe manner with limited property and environmental impacts.


Since the last round of workshops three years ago, changes have been made to all of the retained alternatives, particularly to the Blue Alternative (longest eastern bypass) and the Yellow On-alignment Alternative through Selbyville. These changes will be shown on maps and discussed during the workshop presentations. DeIDOT has preliminarily identified the Blue/Yellow Alternative as the Recommended Preferred Alternative.

DeIDOT and the project team have continued to work with State and Federal environmental resource and regulatory agencies as the alternatives have been refined.

The Georgetown-Millsboro East-to-East Alternative, which was the subject of the last public workshop held in 2007, was dropped largely as a result of public input. The last Selbyville public workshop was in 2006. Be sure to come out and tell us what you think about the alternatives.

Thanks for staying involved! Comments will be taken through July 2, 2010.

They will be used to assist in finalizing the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) required for the project to move forward.
