




Start by copying FastBidX.dll to your hard drive. It is recommended to copy it to the root drive of your computer, otherwise known as the C:\ drive. The picture below shows an example:



Once you have copied the file to the root drive of your computer, you must open up a command prompt window. Do this by clicking Start, Run like the picture below:




Once you have clicked on the run button, type in CMD and then hit OK in the window that appears. That should bring up the following window:



You now have a command prompt window open. The next step is to type in:
Regsvr32 c:\fastbidx.dll

Once you have done that, the only thing you need to do is open .CAL files using Internet Explorer. There are a few different ways to do this. The easiest would be to find a .CAL file, right click on it, and click on **Open With...** like the following picture:



When the new window opens, click on Internet Explorer from the list of programs and make sure that **Always use the selected program to open this kind of file** is selected, then hit OK. That should look like the following picture:



You must be sure that the .CAL file is in a directory path that does not have any spaces in the name(s). For example, you cannot place the .CAL file in a directory path that looks like this:

C:\Documents and Settings\user\My Documents (because there are spaces in the file path)

However, you may place the .CAL file in a directory path that looks like this:

C:\user\DelDOT_ArchivePlans\
