UNIFIED CARRIER REGISTRATION PROGRAM

Delaware is participating in the Unified Carrier Registration Program (UCR) for the year 2008 and subsequent years. Fees due can be paid to Delaware either through www.ucr.in.gov or you may mail your application and payment to the address listed above. Application and payment may also be submitted in person to Motor Fuel Tax staff located at 303 Transportation Circle, Room 112, Dover, Delaware.

The UCR requires individuals and companies that operate commercial motor vehicles (including trailers) interstate (between states) or international commerce to register their business with a participating state and pay an annual fee based on the size of their fleet (MCS-150).

A "Commercial Motor Vehicle" is defined as a self-propelled or towed vehicles used on the highways in commerce principally to transport passengers or cargo, if the vehicle:

- Has a gross vehicle weight of 10,001 pounds or greater
- Is designed to transport 11 or more passengers (including the driver)
- Is used in transporting hazardous materials in a quantity requiring placarding

If you offer services as a Freight Forwarder, Broker or Leasing Company and you make arrangements for the transportation of cargo and goods in interstate or international commerce you are required to register your business with a participating state and pay the annual fee of \$39.00.

If you have not filed your 2007 payment you will need to do so online at www.ucr.in.gov and choose one of the participating states (CT, MA, ME, NH, NY, RI, VA, or WV) to receive your payment. Delaware did not participate in 2007, but you are still required to pay under United States Code (U.S.C.) Title 49.

States will begin enforcement on June 1, 2008. Enforcement varies from state to state; therefore it is strongly recommended that fees for 2007 and 2008 be paid prior to the June 1st enforcement date. A 2008 UCR application has been provided for your convenience.

To avoid delays it is highly recommended that you register on-line. Go to www.ucr.in.gov and follow the step-by-step instructions. Payments may be made on-line using MasterCard, Visa or e-Check.
