

## **Expect Delays for the Wipeout Run at Daniel S. Frawley Stadium Saturday, June 13**

**Wilmington** –As a public courtesy, the Department of Transportation (DelDOT) and the City of Wilmington Police want to inform motorists to expect traffic delays for the Wipeout Run event beginning at 7 a.m. until 4 p.m. on Saturday, June 13 at Daniel S. Frawley Stadium, 801 Shipyard Drive in Wilmington.

DelDOT will be posting directional signs for motorists approaching the area and will also warn motorists of expected traffic delays. Please obey the direction of City of Wilmington Police and DelDOT personnel around the event area and plan extra time in your trip to account for possible traffic delays.

Event parking will occur off site away from the stadium. Riverfront businesses will remain open and business parking will not be impacted.

DelDOT's Transportation Management Center (TMC) staff in coordination with the City of Wilmington Police will monitor traffic in and around the Frawley Stadium to ensure safe travel for motorists.

Motorists can adjust their routes or travel times by using DelDOT's Smartphone application.
