## NOTICE

### **The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) Update of the Consultation Process for Non-Metropolitan Locally Elected and Appointed Officials**

The Division of Planning is responsible for documenting the planning process that DelDOT uses to consult with local government officials in Non-Metropolitan areas of the State of Delaware. This documentation is a federal requirement under 23 CFR 450.210(b) and applies to non-urbanized areas that are outside of a Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) boundary. In Delaware, the non-metropolitan area consists of the majority of Sussex County with exception of the area covered by the Salisbury/Wicomico MPO. In accordance with 23 CFR 450.210(b), the Division of Planning has updated the **Consultation Process for Non-Metropolitan Locally Elected and Appointed Officials** (the “Document”) and is soliciting comments and proposed changes from nonmetropolitan local officials and other interested parties regarding the effectiveness of the consultation process. The comment period will last for 60 days and **will close on April 11, 2016**. Non-Metropolitan local officials and other interested persons are invited to express their views in writing, giving reasons for support of, or opposition to, the current process as outlined in the Document.
