Through a partnership between DelDOT and the Government Efficiency & Accountability Review Board (GEAR), the Traffic Count and Preliminary Traffic Impact Study (PTIS) Critical Items for Acceptance documents have been developed to better align customers on submission requirements, improve the quality and accuracy of TIS/TOA submissions, and reduce unnecessary or duplicative information.

Effective March 1, 2026, all TIS/TOA Traffic Count and PTIS submissions must include all elements outlined in the applicable Critical Items for Acceptance documents.
