# Transportation Improvement Districts


- A TID District is an area in which development is expected to occur and for which Traffic Impact Studies have already been completed.
- A local government initiates.
- DelDOT holds meetings with the public and with the city or the county to establish boundaries, levels of service, density and other expectations

# Transportation Improvement Districts

- The process enables DelDOT to determine the requirements that developers would face.
- This enables developers to know the cost of road improvements up front and to pay for improvements as building progresses.
- In a TID, developers don't have to wait for Traffic Impact Studies.


Current New Castle County TIDs
