

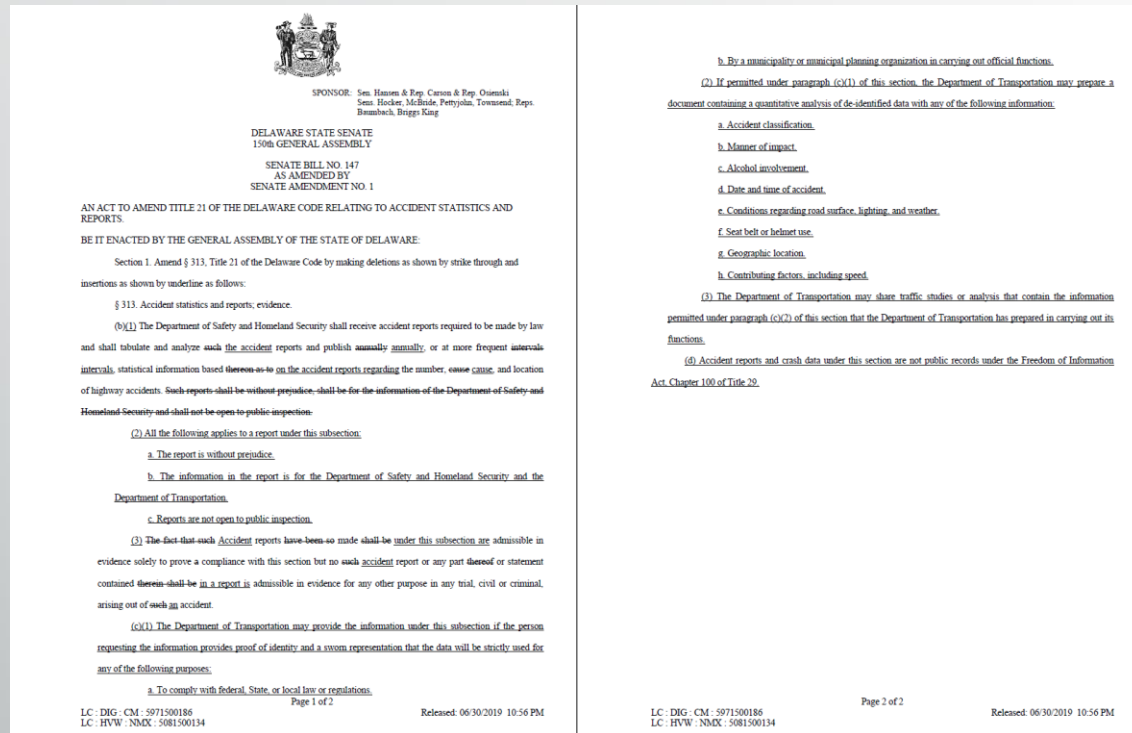


# Delaware Crash Data Release Update

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# Senate Bill 147



- Permits DeIDOT to release de-identified crash statistics when complying by Federal or State law.
  - Commonly known as the “crash summary”.
- Release of the data now requires proof of identity from external (non-DeIDOT) requestors
  - This is done via a notarized data release agreement, found within the online request form.

**Data Formats**

Format Descriptions:

- **SUMMARY** - Tables in PDF format displaying number of crashes, dates, crash types and circumstances, location, etc.
- **EXCEL TABLES** - Summary results in spreadsheet format
- **KMZ** - Summary results in Google Earth Format
- **SAFETY PROGRAM SITES** - Includes HEP, HRRRP, HRGX

- Use online request form.
- Data release form is contained within the request tool.
  - Must be completed and notarized.
  - Requests will not be processed without a completed form!
- Provide as much information as possible about the locations of study.
- Please allow 5-10 business days for processing.

# Next Steps

- DeIDOT Traffic is working with DTI on a new Crash Data Request “Portal”
  - Eliminates the need for notarized forms for every request
  - Allows requestors more flexibility with the input of pertinent information
  - Allows DeIDOT to communicate with the requestor through the application rather than email
  - Allows both DeIDOT and the requestor to track the status of each request
- DeIDOT Traffic will keep Development Coordination apprised of its progress.
