 (d) Accident reports and crash data under this section are not public records under the Freedom of Information 1: Chapter 100 of Title 20.

- Permits DelDOT to release deidentified crash statistics when complying by Federal or State law.
 - Commonly known as the "crash summary".
- Release of the data now requires proof of identity from external (non-DelDOT) requestors
 - This is done via a notarized data release agreement, found within the online request form.

- Use online request form.
- Data release form is contained within the request tool.
 - Must be completed and notarized.
 - Requests will not be processed without a completed form!
- Provide as much information as possible about the locations of study.
- Please allow 5-10 business days for processing.

Next Steps

- DelDOT Traffic is working with DTI on a new Crash Data Request "Portal"
 - Eliminates the need for notarized forms for every request
 - Allows requestors more flexibility with the input of pertinent information
 - Allows DelDOT to communicate with the requestor through the application rather than email
 - Allows both DelDOT and the requestor to track the status of each request
- DelDOT Traffic will keep Development Coordination apprised of its progress.
