



Project Description: Approved in Round 2 for an award of \$825,000, redevelopment of the former Hercules building, 2,000+ jobs, signed TIIF Agreement dated February 19, 2021;

TIIF Scope of Work:

- Phase 1 Streetscaping including new curb, sidewalk pavers, street tree planter work along W 13th St and N Market St site frontages - COMPLETED
- Phase 2 Paving of W 13th St, N Market St and improvements to W 13th St/N Orange St intersection and W 13th St and N Market St intersection
- Employment Standard: 52 Jobs created to date (Chancery Market)





- Summary: The Applicant has requested interim progress payment for Phase 1 of improvements, \$132,250.00
 - Per Grant Agreement, the Grantee may apply to the Council for approval of interim progress reimbursement of less than the entire amount of the Grant without forfeiting the remainder of the Grant.
- The Applicant has requested a grant term extension for the remainder of the award (\$692,750.00) of two years to expire February 2026
 - Admin Code 2312, sec. 6.4 The Council will establish the term of the Grant and the reimbursement schedule. The Council may make recommendation on limitations or grant extensions and may only be withdrawn as set forth in subsection 6.3.









- Project Description: Proposed 3,600 sf office building (outpatient psychiatric mental health services).
- TIIF Scope of Work: Right in/right out consolidated entrance, cross walk and bike lane striping, 10 foot wide shared use path across frontage, drainage
- Employment Standard: 14 Jobs in Year 3




