

### Requests for Reassignment (D2 Pencader to LPC First State Holding) and Progress Payments

- Confirmation that the confirmed and awarded TIIF Award may be reassigned from D2 Pencader, LLC to LPC First State Holding Company, LP
  - ▶ D2 Pencader, LLC sold its interest in the development to LPC First State Holding Company, LP making LPC First State Holding, LP the project developer
  - ▶ LPC First State Holding closed on the property in October 2021
- Consistent with the TIIF Award Agreement allowing Progress Payments with Council approval, approval for the following Progress Payment Schedule:
  - ► Reimbursement of Design Costs and Construction Costs for each Improvement Segment upon issuance of the Acceptance Letter for said Improvement Segment
  - ▶ The approved Improvement Segments are:
    - ▶ SR 896 / GBC Drive / Corporate Blvd. Intersection
    - ▶ SR 896 / Old Cooches Bridge Rd. / Four Seasons Parkway Intersection
    - GBC Drive / Dusk Run Road
    - Old Cooches Bridge Road




# Review & Approval of Received TIIF Grant Applications


- ► Amount available for Awards = \$4.5 million

Limits of Proposed Hudson Road Public Transportation Improvements

- Project Description: Proposed 48.5ksf building with 24-hour, freestanding emergency department, full-service diagnostic imaging center and laboratory, primary care and specialty physician office practices including oncology, cardiology, orthopedics.
- ▶ TIIF Scope of Work: Widen Hudson Road to local road standards (11' travel lanes/5' minimum shoulders), full movement entrance with right turn lane with bike lane and dedicated left turn lane, 10' wide shared use path along Hudson Road with connection to proposed G&L Trail.
- Employment Standard: 60.8 New Jobs
- Public Endorser: Sussex County Administrator Todd Lawson



▶ Financial Stability: One compliance issue has been identified, resolution pending receipt of additional information.
