

# **Getting started with Autodesk:**


Autodesk provides students and educators with a <u>free</u> renewable one-year educational access to their products and services after confirming eligibility.

First, navigate to <a href="https://www.autodesk.com/education/home">https://www.autodesk.com/education/home</a> and click **Select product** to see all available products to download.










### Sign Up and Software Download:

- Click Select on any of the suggested software below to sign up and begin downloading the product
  - AutoCAD: Compatible with Windows and Mac but Mac users must download "AutoCAD for Mac" to use
    the software. AutoCAD Web is cloud based and is compatible with Windows and Mac. Does not require
    a 3D model to create a 2D drawing; users can go straight into creating a 2D drawing
  - Fusion 360: Compatible with Windows and Mac systems. Requires users to create a 3D model before creating a 2D drawing








- Select the plan that represents your educational role
