

Bicycling in Delaware

This map series is just one step that the Delaware Department of Transportation (DeIDOT) is taking to encourage all modes of transportation.

It features a network of State, regional, and connector routes to help cyclists get where they need to go. All roads in the state of Delaware, except limited access or express state highways (which includes I-95 and the Delaware Memorial Bridge), may be traveled by bicycle.

DeIDOT has several road improvement projects and studies to make bicycling and walking safer and more pleasant. These are listed online at delDOT.gov/information/projects/. Any new roadway project in Delaware needs to accommodate bicyclists and pedestrians.


Safety

The Helmet Law
 Children under the age of 18 must wear a helmet while bicycling or in a trailer or bike seat. The helmet law also led to the formation of a bicycle helmet bank to provide free helmets to children who cannot afford to buy them. Helmets are available through the public schools, or you can contact the DeIDOT bicycle coordinator at 302-760-2260.

Get There Safely. Know Your Responsibilities.
 Share the road. Don't assume motorists can see you. Never ride against traffic.
 3Cs: Courtesy, Caution, Common sense.
 Follow signs and signals.

 Wear a helmet
 Use lights at night

Bicycling Routes

Statewide Bicycle Route
 These routes are north-south connections among New Castle, Kent and Sussex Counties.

With Bikeway * Without Bikeway Bicycle Route 1 East Coast Greenway Route

Regional Bicycle Route
 These higher traffic routes provide direct connections between major municipalities and activity centers.

With Bikeway * Without Bikeway

Connector Bicycle Route
 These routes provide connections from local activity and recreational centers to the larger bicycle network. Cyclists may find undersized roads (white) suitable.

With Bikeway * Without Bikeway

* Bikeways include shoulders and wide outside lanes, which may or may not be marked and signed as bike routes. Be alert for occasional turn lanes in these areas.


