






# FY26 - Sources of Funds - \$1,115.6M (in millions)






# FY26 - DelDOT Budget- \$1,115.6M (in millions)











### Debt Service as a % of Revenue








### FY26 and FY27 Projected Revenues and Expenditures



### **DelDOT State Capital Expenditure Programs**








#### **New Castle County**

Federally Eligible = 907 miles (75%) Non-Federally Eligible = 309 miles (25%)






#### **Kent County**

Federally Eligible = 476 miles (40%) Non-Federally Eligible = 704 miles (60%)






#### **Sussex County**








### Kent County Project Candidate – Rank# 11 McKee Road/Saulsbury Road Improvements, US 13 N/S
