

Delaware's Sign Legislation 17 DEL.CODE Sections 524, 525, 526, 526 and 1111(c)

During Election Season: Signs may be placed 30 days prior to a Delaware Department of Elections approved election, but must be removed within 30 days after the election. No sign may ever be placed within 10 feet from the edge of roadway.

Each sign that is in violation results in a fine of \$25, and a \$15 recovery fee.

Signs placed illegally are not only unattractive, but can be dangerous to motorists and pedestrians. For more information on sign placement, see 17 Del. Code, Sections 524-527 and 1111(C).
