

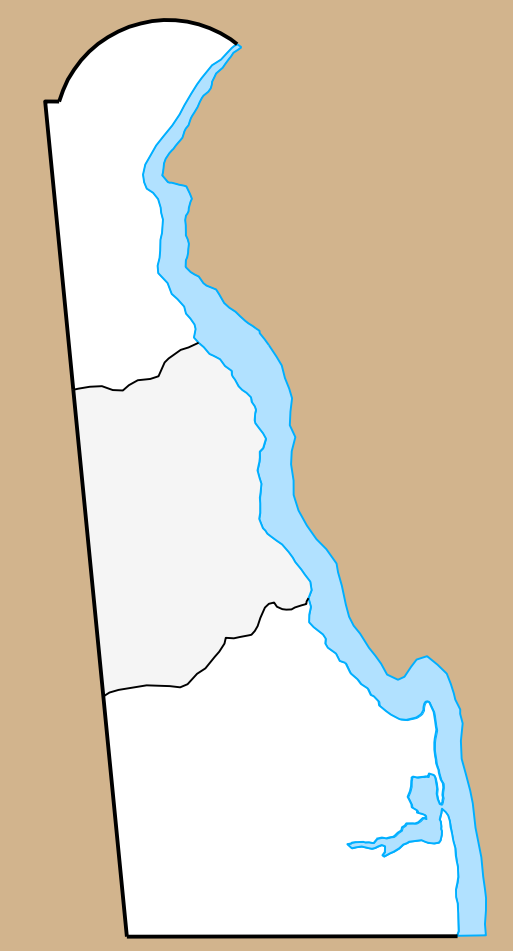

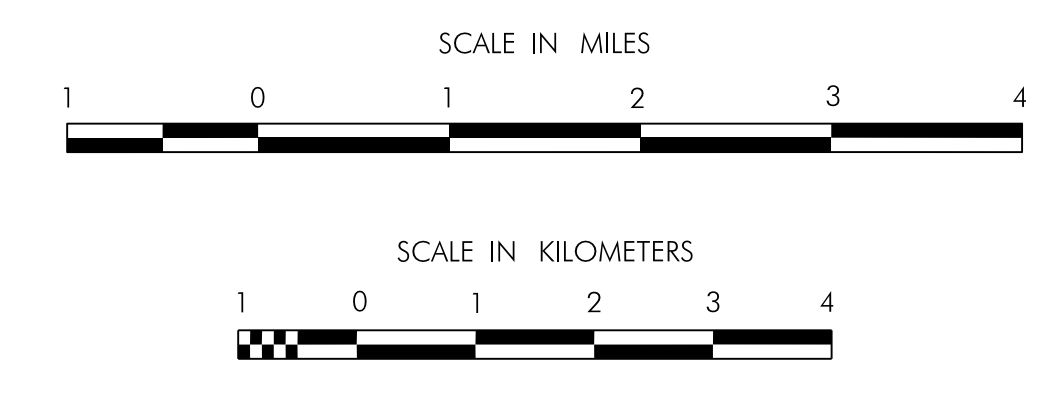

DESIGN AND LAYOUT WERE DEVELOPED USING THE DESIGN AND EDIT CAPABILITIES OF DELDOT'S INTERGRAPH COMPUTER SYSTEM. BASIC INFORMATION WAS CREATED USING U. S. G. S. 1:24,000 MAPS AND THE DELAWARE ATLAS MAPS AT A SCALE OF 1:24,000.
