

## ABSTRACT

The Delaware Department of Transportation retained John Milner Associates, Inc., West Chester, Pennsylvania (JMA) to conduct a cultural resources survey associated with the proposed reconstruction of Delaware Route 1 between Five Points and Rehoboth, Sussex County, Delaware. The purpose of this survey was to identify potentially significant archaeological sites and historical properties in order that they might be afforded proper consideration during project planning. Between March 1987 and April 1988 JMA undertook a program of research and field investigation involving archaeological testing at 283 locations and an architectural inventory of 134 properties, including 329 buildings. As a result of the survey JMA recommended that no archaeological sites within the project area were potentially eligible for the National Register; however, JMA recommended that two historic districts and 13 individual properties appeared to meet the Criteria for Evaluation and should be determined eligible for the National Register.
