- Traffic Flow Map**—A map of Primary and Secondary roads showing 1959 annual average traffic figures. Color bands in three colors are used to illustrate major traffic movements.
- Delaware Official Road Map**—Official Tourist Map. Printed in full color and illustrates features of the State with photographs and descriptive notes. Shows state roads, U.S. Routes and other details.
- Highway Condition Bulletin**—A map showing major construction projects and detours in effect during the construction period. Published monthly except December, January, February and March.

- (c) **County Maintenance Maps**—Sussex County map printed in black on white with water detail in blue. Same details as the State Highway Map.
- (d) **County Hundreds Maps**—Hundreds Division boundary lines and names overprinted in color on small county maps. New Castle and Kent County Divisions are printed on small County General Highway Maps and Sussex Divisions on the small Sussex County Maintenance Map.
