GUIDE TO ATTACHMENT VII

POST-1802 SENSITIVITY ZONES

This appendix lists the major historic sensitivity zones for the post-1802 period. These zones are mapped on USGS 7.5' maps in Attachment VII.

Saint Georges Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Major transpeninsular road (central route); Route 13.
- Zone 2: Major transpeninsular road (western route); Routes 71, 301, 4, County Road 435; railroad corridor.
- Zone 3: Secondary east-west connector road.
- Zone 4: Interior settlement.

Middletown Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Major transpeninsular road (central route); Route 13.
- Zone 2: Major transpeninsular road (western route); Routes 71, 301, 4, County Road 435, railroad corridor.
- Zone 3: Secondary east-west connector road.
- Zone 4: Interior settlement.
- Zone 5: Railroad town.

Taylor's Bridge Quadrangle

- Zone 4: Interior settlement.

Clayton Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Major transpeninsular road (central route); Route 13.
- Zone 3: Secondary east-west connector road.
- Zone 4: Interior settlement.

Smyrna Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Major transpeninsular road (central route); Route 13.
- Zone 3: Secondary east-west connector road.
- Zone 4: Interior settlement.
- Zone 5: Railroad town.
- Zone 6: Major water navigational route.

Dover Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Major transpeninsular road (central route); Route 13
- Zone 4: Interior settlement.

Wyoming Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Major transpeninsular road (central route); Route 13.
- Zone 4: Interior settlement

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Kenton Quadrangle

- Zone 3: Secondary east-west connector road.
- Zone 4: Interior settlement.

Little Creek Quadrangle

- Zone 4: Interior settlement
- Zone 6: Major water navigational route.

Frederica Quadrangle

- Zone 3: Secondary east-west connector road.
- Zone 4: Interior settlement.
