BAILEY COLLECTION

Bailey Collection

The Mrs. James W. Bailey collection comes from several locations on the Bailey family farm near Smyrna, Delaware, southwest of the confluence of Duck and Mill Creeks. Mrs. Bailey's collection, totaling 3,545 artifacts, is provenienced partly by exact site locations, partly to the northern half of the farm ("north field"), and partly to the farm in general. Two previously recorded sites 7K-A-10 and A-11 are located on the farm and her collection contains artifacts from these sites as well. See Figure 24 for the location of the Bailey farm sites.

Mrs. Bailey is knowledgeable about prehistoric artifact types and collected all artifacts, including debitage. Thus collector bias is minimal with this collection.

All of the Bailey collection which can be provenienced appears to be from the Woodland I period - mostly stemmed points and nondiagnostic fragments. A cache of 24 large argillite bifaces is also exactly located (see Plate 22). The unprovenienced artifacts include diagnostic bifaces from the Paleo-Indian, Archaic, Woodland I, and Woodland II Periods, Woodland I and II ceramics, and ground stone tools. Unutilized waste flakes make up 60% of all artifacts.
