Robert Wier's Day Book ("Shop No. 1") Feb. 20, 1830 to Oct. 14, 1833 [Christiana, Delaware] 243 pp.

* The following are selections from Wier's Day book. One day from each month (in this case, the 23rd of the month) was picked and all of the transactions that Wier undertook were recorded. The years beginning in Feb 23, 1830 to Feb. 23, 1832 were sampled. In several cases, the 23rd day of the month had no information recorded -- either Wier didn't work, or it was a holiday or Sunday. For whatever reason, a random day from the month was chosen so that there would still be a sample of the type of work that Wier conducted. Later in the book, it became obvious that Wier was recording some days -- either prior to or after the 23rd -- in the entry for the 23rd. These pieces were recorded anyway, but technically they did not occur on the 23rd of the month.
