Obeying Bicycle Laws *Will Keep You Safe!*






Delaware is Serious About Enforcing Bike Safety Laws

Use Hand Signals



Right Way to Turn Left

Ride on right, carefully move to the left of lane for left hand turn.



Always Ride in the Same Direction as Traffic



Use Proper Safety Equipment



Helmet
(Required by law if under the age of 16, but recommended for all ages.)

Reflective Clothing

Headlight and Reflectors on Your Bike

Obey All Traffic Signs & Signals



Stop

Clear the Intersection

Go
