

BLUE BALL DAIRY BARN (cont'd)



Reconstruction activities at the Blue Ball Dairy Barn have become the primary focus along West Park Drive. The barn will soon provide residents with an impressive community meeting facility, and a permanent display of Delaware's Folk Art Collection and historic artifacts found by archaeologists working at the Weldin Ruins.



A new addition will provide catering facilities and an elevator, which will permit easy access to all areas of the barn. Site improvements include a stone-paved entry courtyard, vehicle drop-off area, and a 50-car paved parking area with 100 overflow parking spaces on the lawn.

A large public lawn immediately to the south of the barn will be maintained for community gatherings and for the informal enjoyment of members of the public. A garden is also planned for north of the building, a site that many remember as the kitchen garden for the barn.
