US 113 Intersection Improvements Highway Safety Improvement Program Projects

The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) invites the public to attend a public workshop to obtain an update on the status of the Preliminary Design for proposed improvements to various intersections along U.S. Route 113 in Sussex County. Interested members of the public are invited to attend at any time between 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Attendees will have an opportunity to review display materials and provide comments to DelDOT representatives.

Proposed improvements to the intersections listed below will be presented at the public workshop:

In the Millsboro area

- US 113 at SR 20
- US 113 at Sheep Pen Road / Bark Pond Road
- US 113 at Cricket Street / Molly Field Road
- US 113 at Radish Road / 2nd Street
- US 113 at Hickory Hill Road / Delaware Avenue
- US 113 at Dagsboro Road (SR 20) / Handy Road

North of Ellendale

• US 113 at Staytonville Road / Fleatown Road

These intersections have historically experienced high rates of accidents and as a result, were included as part of the Department's Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). The proposed intersection improvements may include (but are not limited to) median channelization and/or median closures to restrict certain movements to address safety and operational concerns at each intersection. The safety projects will minimize conflicts at the intersection while accommodating the heaviest turning movements and diverting traffic volumes to nearby intersections. This project will identify and address safety and operational improvements at each intersection.

Interested persons are invited to express their views in writing, giving reasons for support of or in opposition to the proposed project. Comments will be received during the workshop or can be mailed to DelDOT Public Relations, P.O. Box 778, Dover, DE 19903.
