

US 113 at Millsboro Towne Square/1st Street

Intersection Improvements

Project Scope

- US 113 intersects with 1st Street and the Millsboro Towne Square entrance in Millsboro. The current intersection configuration has two offset legs, with 1st Street being one-way in the eastbound direction, located approximately 30 feet north of the Millsboro Town Square entrance. The Millsboro Towne Square entrance has a shared through, left-turn, and right-turn lane for its approach to US 113. Northbound and southbound US 113 have two through lanes and a left turn lane at this intersection. This project will construct median channelization to allow US 113 northbound and southbound left turns only through the median.

Project Justification

- This intersection has been designated Site L in the 2011 Hazard Elimination Program.
- Accident History:
Between January of 2007 and September 2011 the intersection has seen:
 - 13 SB/EB angle crashes
 - 6 NB/EB angle crashes
 - 2 NB /WB angle crashes
 - 1 EB left-turn/WB through
- Channelizing the median movements into left turns only will reduce the number of crashes at this intersection. It will accommodate the heaviest turning movements without creating a stop condition on US 113.

Project Schedule

- **Right-of-Way Acquisition:** No right-of-way needed.
- **Construction:** Spring 2016

Estimated Project Cost

- \$200,000
