



Pedestrian Safety

- Provide universal accessibility through the addition of compliant ADA curb ramps
- Improved pedestrian safety by shortening crossing distances and improving visibility
- Traffic calming
- Increased quantity of crossings

Aesthetics

- Reinforce the identity of Newark and create a sense of place
- Public art to showcase local artists or the unique aspects of Newark
- Softened architectural/infrastructure through landscaping

Economic Development

- Encourage increased pedestrian traffic downtown
- Provide additional amenities downtown to increase business patronage
- Increase shade canopy to increase comfort for business patrons

Green Technologies

- Increased opportunities for stormwater management
- Landscaped green infrastructure to provide opportunities to reduce stormwater runoff and improve water quality
- Softened architectural/infrastructure through landscaping






