IRIB CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY GROUP
Meeting #32 Minutes

WELCOME: Andrew Bing started the 32nd meeting of the Construction Advisory Group (CAG) at 10:00 AM by welcoming the attendees.

Andrew reminded all attendees to sign in and stated that there were copies of the minutes from the October CAG meeting at the front of the room. Andrew informed the attendees that the minutes from the October CAG meeting were also on the IRIB website.

Andrew informed the CAG that this meeting will be the last meeting for the CAG focused on the bridge construction. The CAG meetings will continue into 2012 but will be focused on the Roadway and Demolition Project and on the Park Improvement Project.

Andrew stated that there would be brief updates but the main focus of this meeting is to celebrate the new bridge and the successful CAG process.

Bridge Update

Jay Erwin, Skanska Project Manager, stated that this is a joyous time of the year and that he is proud to be a part of the new Indian River Inlet Bridge project. Jay said he has been pleased to keep the CAG at the forefront of the bridge activities and feels the CAG process has been a big success for the project. Jay stated that the new bridge is a very important project to Skanska, to DelDOT and most importantly to the citizens of Delaware.

Jay then went through a retrospective slide show from the beginning of the project to the current day, focusing on various milestones for the project.

Doug Robb thanked Skanska and also thanked the CAG for being such an important part of the process. Doug stated that although there is no firm opening date for the bridge, that all signs point to a mid to late January opening of the bridge to two lanes of traffic (one lane in each direction.)

Tina Shockley commented that there will be a ribbon-cutting ceremony for the new bridge and that more specific details will be worked out in advance of the event.
