

- **Project Details**
  - Project length = 4.14 Miles
  - School (Lord Baltimore Elementary), Fire Station (Millville), Post Office, Major Grocery Stores, and numerous Medical Offices located within the project limits
  - Partially within both Town of Millville and Town of Ocean View
- **Project Design Details**
  - Over 6 linear miles of curb
  - Over 3.5 linear miles of sidewalk
  - Over 5.5 linear miles of pipe (320 pipes)
  - 250 drainage inlets
  - Five signalized intersections
  - 237 entrances (approx. 57 per Section of Construction or 1 per 100')
  - Four Stormwater Management Ponds
  - Two bridge (culvert) replacements
  - Over 240 Utility poles to relocate
- **Parcel Impacts**
  - Acquisitions from 250 parcels
  - Adjacent to 272 parcels
- **Design**
  - Environmental Assessment (Federal Document) approved September 2008
  - Real Estate Acquisitions began in 2008
  - Final Plans due December 2012
- **For Construction Purposes, the project has been broken into four sections (approx. 1 mile long)**
  - Section 1 – Woodland Ave to Assawoman Canal (Town of Ocean View)
  - Section 2 – Windmill Road to Woodland Avenue (Town of Millville)
  - Section 3 – East of SR 17 to Windmill Road (Town of Millville)
  - Section 4 – Clarksville to East of SR 17
- **Construction Phasing and Timing**
  - Early Action areas at Clarksville and Cedar Drive (under traffic)
  - Section 1 and 3 will be constructed concurrently (under traffic)
  - Section 2 and 4 will be constructed concurrently (under traffic)
  - Culverts will be replaced during the winter with a complete road closure. Both will be constructed at the same time.
- **Public Outreach to date**
  - Three public workshops have been held (2004, 2005, 2006)
  - Numerous meetings held with the Towns (Ocean View and Millville)
  - Meetings held with Chamber of Commerce (including the business owners along SR 26)
  - Coordination with School District and Emergency Response Agencies
  - Meeting with Community Groups (Rotary Club, Homeowners Assoc., etc.)
  - Project Newsletters generated/mass mailings sent
