### **TTX** Overview of events

- Two exercises:
  - Kent County (October 2010)
  - New Castle County (September 2011)
- Recommendations were identified at each exercise which have been used to develop next steps.





Recommendations

#### **Detour Plans**

- Share the level 1 detour plans with TMTs only.
- Add exit numbers and identify the most critical traffic control points to these plans (level 1s).
- Develop the ability to search for detours in tabular fashion by exit numbers.
- Discontinue sharing level 3 (intersection diagram) plans with TMTs.



Recommendations

#### **Detour Selection During an Incident**

 Selection and activation of detour plans will be performed by DeIDOT's TMC. The TMC technician will conduct the conflict analysis for construction, congestion, and other incidents/detours as part of this process.



Recommendations

#### **Detour Traffic Control Point Resources**

- Direction of DelDOT detour resources to traffic control points is the responsibility of the DelDOT Supervisor at the scene, rather than the Incident Commander.
- Consider Fire Police at traffic control points temporary assets to be replaced by DelDOT personnel as soon as possible.



Recommendations

#### **Incident Response Trailers**

 Continue marketing the incident response trailers through the TMT meetings with demonstrations and updates.



Recommendations

#### Communications

- Continue to train DeIDOT TMC Technicians to proactively anticipate in-field needs, even when this may not be clear in the computer aided dispatch (CAD) log. Develop a list of key words (e.g., fatal, trauma) to aid in this effort.
- Note in the CAD log when an incident is cleared so DeIDOT can break down the activated detour, update public information, and deactivate Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) assets.



Recommendations

#### **Response Time**

- Continue tracking after-hours responses to understand if implementing a night shift for DeIDOT's incident response is warranted.
- Anticipate needing DeIDOT's assistance based on the nature of the incident, and request this assistance as soon as possible to reduce response time.

Recommendations

#### Communications Method and Standard Operating Procedure

- Investigate the feasibility of a common communications link between DeIDOT and the Fire Police and implement a solution while radio rebanding is underway in Delaware.
- Develop a standard operating procedure between DeIDOT and the Fire Police which creates a statewide standard for radio use by personnel responding to incidents.

Recommendations

#### **Interim Communications Protocol**

 Develop an interim communications protocol utilizing a statewide mutual aid channel for incident operations communication between DelDOT and Fire Police.



### New Castle County TTX

Recommendations

#### **Establishment of Traffic Control Points**

• Consider detour plans where DelDOT control points are established in advance of Fire Police control points.

#### **Coordination with Fire Police**

- Coordination efforts are being scheduled with Delaware Fire Police Association on communication in general, topics to include:
  - Systems
    - Radios and radio channels
    - Other communications methods
  - Protocols
    - Interim and long term communications procedures
    - Mutual aid channels and dedicated talk groups
    - Centralized communications via the TMC and CAD
