I. Opening Remarks

Establish TMT Communications Working Group

Gene reported that Edwards and Kelcey is developing a draft SOP on procedures for the scene of an incident. This SOP document will be reviewed at the next Communications Working Group meeting scheduled for January 11, 2006 at 10:00 AM at the Kent County 911 Center.

Conduct Transportation Management Training

Gene stated that he is working with Maryland State Highway in gathering materials for training courses. Gene also mentioned that training would be scheduled for sometime in the spring.

Quick Clearance Policy

Gene explained that he would be looking for volunteers from each TMT group to aid him in the development of a unified standard draft on Quick Clearance for the state of Delaware. Currently seven (7) states in the I-95 Corridor Coalition already have laws established in this matter.

Spanish Language Aid for Incident Response Booklet

Gene mentioned that this item is moving forward; DelDOT is trying to work through the payment issue of one state (Delaware) paying another state (Maryland).

Special Items of Interest

Gene mentioned the following items to the Kent County TMT Committee:

- All three (3) TMT Committees in Sussex County will be having a combined meeting on Evacuation Routes scheduled for 7:00 PM on January 18, 2006 at the Millsboro Fire Department.
- New Castle County and DelDOT will be conducting a pilot project on developing a more efficient and timely way of ordering tow trucks for disabled vehicles and incidents on DelDOT highways.
- Due to a recent handling of roadways around Dover Air Force Base due to a bomb scare incident, DelDOT will be conducting a special meeting with officials from the base to review roadway-closing procedures.
