Two new alternatives have been developed that would combine the east bypass around Georgetown with the east bypass around Millsboro. These new alternatives will be presented to the public for the first time at area workshops on March 12th and 15th.

**Public workshops highlight refined Retained Alternatives**

in June 2006, the Alternatives Retained for Detailed Study, including the new alternatives, have been refined.
