

The New Castle County Department of Land Use, Floodplain Administrator, in conjunction with the Delaware Department of Transportation (DeIDOT), hereby gives notice of the New Castle County's intent to revise the flood hazard information, as shown on FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Map Numbers 10003C0241L, 10003C0242L, and 10003C0243L, generally located from downstream of US 13 to upstream of Hyetts Corner Road. Specifically, the flood hazard information shall be revised along Scott Run from a point approximately 580 feet downstream of US 13 NB to a point approximately 1,600 feet upstream of Hyetts Corner Road and along Unnamed Tributary to Scott Run from its confluence with Scott Run to approximately 1,600 feet upstream of the confluence with Scott Run.

As a result of the revision, the 1% annual chance water-surface elevations shall increase and decrease and be established, and the 1% annual chance floodplain shall widen and narrow within the area of revision along Scott Run. As a result of the revision, the 1% annual chance water-surface elevations shall increase and be established, and the 1% annual chance floodplain shall widen and narrow and be established within the area of revision along Unnamed Tributary to Scott Run.
