

# Improvements Are Needed

## Existing and Potential Future Cut-Through Traffic Issues



Significant cut-through traffic occurs on roads between New Burton and Route 13A under existing conditions.

Of the traffic heading south down Saulsbury Road and the traffic heading east on North Street during AM peak hour, 38% use the following roads to reach Route 13A:

| 2. Webbs Lane        | 8%  |
| 3. Dover Street      | 7%  |
| 4. Kesselring Avenue | 5%  |
| 5. Waples Avenue     | 1%  |

- License plate matching surveys conducted at various locations within the study area confirmed the cut-through traffic concerns identified by the public outreach process.
- With estimated growth in potential future traffic volumes, cut-through traffic problems will increase.
