

Online Virtual Public Workshop for US 9 (Kings Highway) from SR 1 to Freeman Highway

Wednesday, February 23, 2022 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.

DelDOT is holding an online virtual public workshop on **Wednesday**, **February 23**, **2022** to obtain public input on the proposed widening and intersection improvements along Kings Highway (US 9) to improve traffic operations and add additional capacity to accommodate future growth. Intersection improvements are proposed at the existing Kings Highway intersections with Dartmouth Drive, Clay Road, Gills Neck Road, and Freeman Highway as well as adding a new intersection between Gills Neck Road and Freeman Highway.
