

The Mulberry Knoll Road Extension PEL Study is evaluating possible transportation improvements to the east-west corridor, which parallels Coastal Highway (SR 1) and Plantation Road, between Lewes Georgetown Highway (US 9) and John Williams Highway (SR 24) in Sussex County, Delaware.
