Dear Following Five Points reader,

As we continue working together to slow the spread of COVID-19, we wanted to bring you a few project-related updates:

April 2020 Working Group Materials

Even though the Working Group meeting originally scheduled for **Monday, April 27, 2020** was cancelled, several updates have been made to the **Implementation Plan**. As of April 2020:

- 39 of 78 recommendations are in progress, ongoing or completed.
 - 1 recommendation that was in progress is now complete.
 - 1 recommendation that was listed as in progress is now classified as **ongoing**.
 - 5 recommendations remain to be initiated in 2020.

Save the Date: Virtual Public Open House

The **public open house** originally scheduled for **May 18, 2020** is moving forward as a **Virtual Open House**. Below is the current schedule of virtual public open houses:
