PURPOSE

- To develop transportation improvements that accommodate the anticipated growth in local, seasonal and through traffic


N E E D

- The January 2003 Sussex County Comprehensive Plan identifies the need:
  - To increase capacity on US 113
  - To accommodate through and local traffic
  - To assure viability for agriculture
  - To expand travel alternatives, where feasible
  - To improve US 113 as an emergency evacuation route
- The Kent County Comprehensive Plan Update identifies the need to improve operating conditions on US 113 in designated growth areas
- The City of Milford 2003 Comprehensive Plan Update identifies the need for study of an eastern and western bypass



Georgetown-South Area Study Purpose and Need


