Purpose Of Workshop: Present And Listen

The purpose of this sixth round of Public Workshops is to obtain input from you, the public, allowing DelDOT to further refine the Alternatives Retained for Detailed Study, develop a recommendation for a Preferred Alternative and prepare a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS). DelDOT currently anticipates making the DEIS available for public and agency comments in May 2007 and conducting a public hearing in June 2007.

The Retained Alternatives have been refined in response to comments and input from the June 2006 public workshops and the Milford Area Working Group, and the continuing consultation with the Federal and State environmental resource and regulatory agencies.

In response to comments from the Milford Area Working Group and the June 2006 workshops, the Brown Alternative has been included as an Alternative Retained for Detailed Study. It is being evaluated by the Project Team and reviewed by the environmental resource and regulatory agencies in the same detailed manner as the other Retained Alternatives.

Public input throughout this study is welcomed and encouraged. Comments on this round of Workshops will be accepted through March 16, 2007.
